## **INTRODUCTION:**

This item is to request that the City Council Accept the Report and Authorize Staff to Begin the Recruitment Process for the openings on the Climate Action Committee.

## **BACKGROUND:**

At its January 7, 2020 meeting, the Council authorized the formation and composition of the Climate Action Committee (CAC) to address climate change policy and issues. At its October 20, 2020 meeting the Council appointed the initial members to the CAC. Since that time, a two year term limit was set, with CAC members initially volunteering for either 2 or 3-year terms

The CAC composition is flexible, up to 13 members appointed by Council. The current membership is as follows, with positions to be announced as part of this recruitment highlighted in yellow (those not highlighted are either appointed by the Council/Planning Commission, or would have terms ending December 2023):
