<p>7/14/21</p>	<p>SUMMARY</p> <p><i>Fossil fuel infrastructure:</i> RCPA to reconvene in September to finalize proposed ordinances. Recommendation that planning commission to review this idea; Luke to serve as liaison. Per Kari, ordinance can be quite simple. Transportation group will continue to move this idea forward, focussing on new gas stations.</p> <p><i>Chair reports:</i> Public meeting tomorrow regarding collaboration between local climate groups, okay for CAC members to attend as long as they do not discuss ideas currently in front of CAC and disclose attendance if future committee business refers back to discussions had at this event.</p> <p><i>Working Group reports:</i> Energy and funding continue to develop projects: UUT, transfer tax, methane use reduction, electrification. Education/outreach group has placed item in city newsletter, has written press releases re: CAC work and open seats; also art project moving forward and funding included in city budget. Recommendation to present to Public Art Committee as soon as possible.
