Consent Calendar Items Include:

- **Porchfest Fee Waiver:** Consider approving a \$500 fee reimbursement to Porchfest organizers for their September 13 event. (Public Works; \$500 General Fund impact)
- **Community Cultural Center Project Completion:** Approve Notice of Completion for fire-related building improvements. (Public Works; no new fiscal impact)
- **Committee Vacancies Announcements:**
 - **Climate Action Committee:** Two seats expiring Dec. 31, 2025.
 - **Public Arts Committee:** Four seats expiring Dec. 31, 2025.
 - **Design Review & Tree Board:** Three seats expiring Dec. 31, 2025. (Planning Dept.; no additional fiscal impact beyond budgeted costs)
