My name is Justine Epstein. I have been a resident of Sebastopol since 2016, and am a local voter. I am also Jewish.

I am writing today in support of the proposed ceasefire resolution, and implore you to vote YES.

This ceasefire resolution calls for an end to all armed hostilities on both sides, a return of all hostages, and for long-term peace work to be prioritized in Israel/Palestine.
