Dear Mayor and City Council:

We understand that the City Council is beginning its discussion of how it will address Sebastopol's fiscal challenges. We offer our comments regarding one aspect of City funding.

As the City Council is aware, several Sebastopol nonprofit organizations provide a range of services, which, in many other cities, are provided by the city itself through a Parks & Recreation Department. We believe that such services are part of what make a great and economically vibrant community.

In recognition of the services provided by the Sebastopol Community Cultural Center (SCCC), the City of Sebastopol has provided funding support, which supplements the Community Center's self-generated funding. We have used this City funding to support our classes, youth programs and cultural events and concerts.

We greatly appreciate the support of the City in its community-building efforts, which enhance the well-being of the Sebastopol community and contribute to the vitality of local business.

We understand that the City of Sebastopol is facing major projected financial challenges and in response, is considering cutting all of its financial support to the Community Cultural Center. This would have a devastating impact.

We have been working towards greater independent financial sustainability, but this is challenging given our mission of serving the community, providing many classes and events at low- or no-cost, and not being a profit-driven enterprise.

We request that you consider retaining the current level of SCCC funding.
