

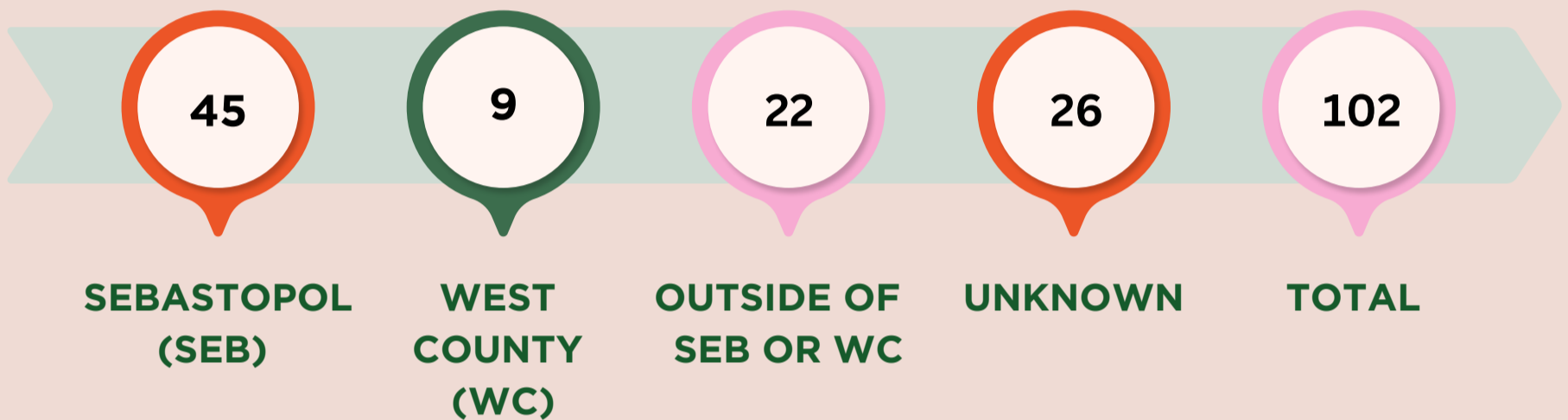
WHO WANTS A CEASEFIRE IN SEBASTOPOL?

INSIGHTS FROM PUBLIC COMMENTS

Making an informed decision on a controversial matter requires factual information. The following data presents the written public comments expressing support, opposition, or neutrality towards a ceasefire resolution in Sebastopol on 02.20.24, along with the origins of these comments. After the ceasefire resolution was removed from the agenda on February 20th, at least 2,146 individuals have lost their lives in Gaza, and another 3,964 have sustained injuries.

Written public comments can come from anywhere, but this analysis focuses on those within the following areas:

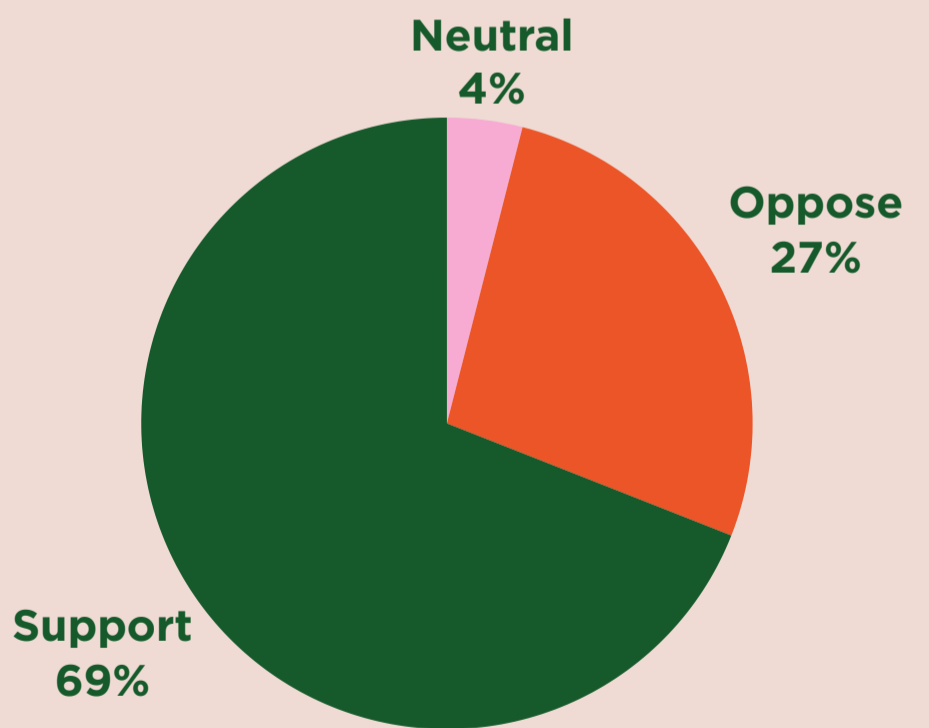


OF AREAS CITY COUNCIL CARES MOST ABOUT: CITY LIMITS AND WEST COUNTY



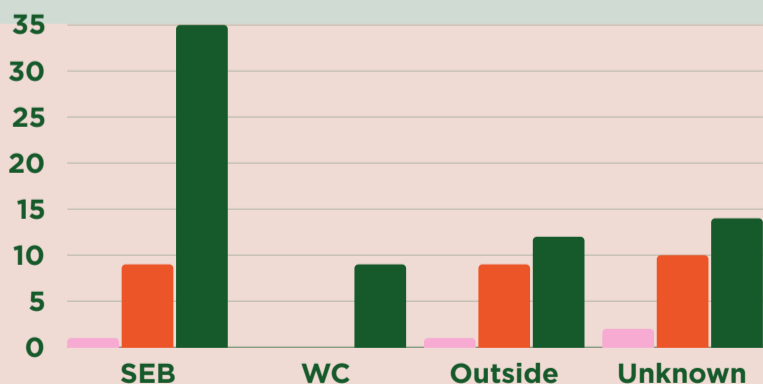
