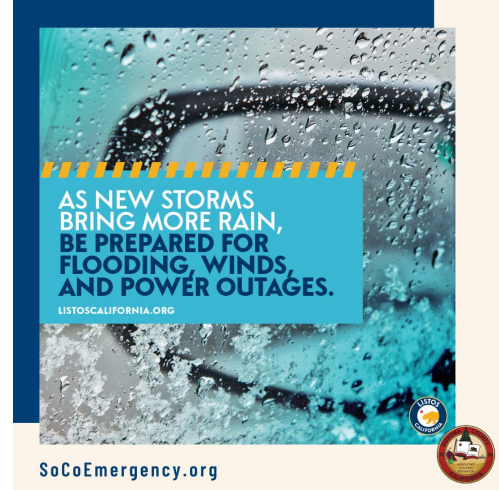


### **SIGNIFICANT WET WEATHER ON THE WAY**

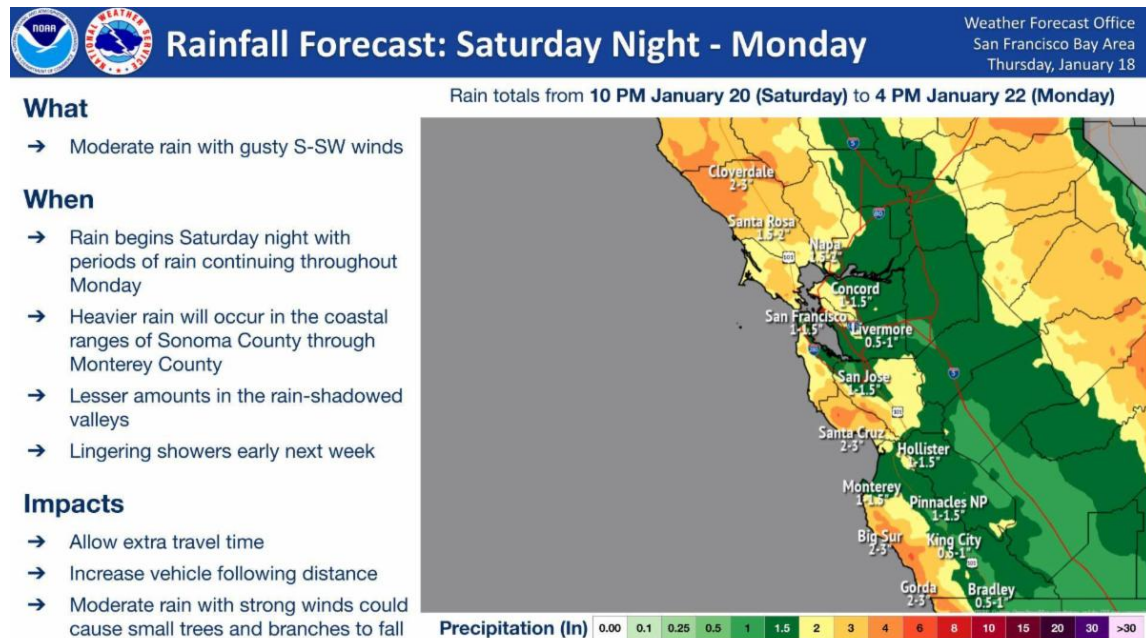
The National Weather Service predicts up to 6" of rain over the next five days. As new storms bring more RAIN, be prepared for flooding, winds and possible power

outages. Localized flooding is possible. Additional preparation and safety tips include:

- Clean out rain gutters and nearby storm drains.
- As rain accumulates, remember to slow down and prepare for longer commute times.
- Never drive through flooded roadways — TURN AROUND, DON'T DROWN!
- Ensure your headlights are turned on for visibility.
- Stay informed about the latest weather forecasts.

## NEED SANDBAGS?

With significant rain in the forecast and the possibility of flooding, the City of Sebastopol Public Works Department offers free sand and sandbags to Sebastopol residents. Individuals may pick up sand and sandbags sunrise to sunset in the city parking area to the rear of the Sebastopol Youth Annex at 425 Morris Street (see map below).

Please note that residents must fill the sandbags themselves. Shovels will be available onsite. The maximum number of bags per resident is 25.

## CITY EXPLORES CREATING ENTERPRISE INFRASTRUCTURE FINANCING DISTRICT (EIFD)

The City Council approved pursuing funding infrastructure needs (roads, water and sewer systems, buildings, etc.) without increasing taxes. We will explore creating what's called an

Enterprise Infrastructure Financing District (EIFD). This process commits a portion of future property taxes to these needs. We are doing this in partnership with the County, which would contribute a portion of their property taxes toward Sebastopol's betterment as we are the commercial hub and host of many public services used by County residents. There

is no cost to the City to pursue this opportunity; the County is providing the initial funding. We have not identified particular projects, and would do so only after public input. We are starting the process to decide whether it makes financial sense to proceed.

## NEW AMBULANCE PROVIDER IN SEBASTOPOL



On Tuesday, January 16th, Sonoma County Fire District began providing ambulance services in our city and throughout most of Sonoma County. The current Posts (predetermined standby locations) that will generally service our city are: Graton Fire, Gold Ridge Fire, and Hwy 12 & Llano Road. Residents may see vehicles around town with "Sonoma County Fire" on them and these are the ambulances servicing our city and county. There is no cost to our city for this level of

service.

## RECYCLE YOUR OLD HOUSEHOLD BATTERIES IN BIN OUTSIDE CITY HALL

Household batteries including alkaline and rechargeable batteries cannot be landfilled in California because they contain acids and toxic metals such as mercury, lead, cadmium, and nickel. Batteries can also be a fire risk so it's important to recycle them properly.

Deposit old batteries in the battery disposal bin at the Sebastopol Regional Library at 7140 Bodega Avenue.



**NOTE:** Drop-off all kinds of household batteries. Tape battery terminals.
