community safety concerns.

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## **RECOMMENDATION:**

That the City Council Approve of Direction to Staff (City Attorney) to prepare ordinances based upon community concerns. Proposed ordinances to address good neighbor policy to foster positive relationships between homeless service providers and the communities they serve mitigating potential negative impacts on neighborhoods and rebuild trust between residents and service providers; ordinance to address property maintenance and related community impacts; and ordinance to provide standards for public space use and address community safety concerns.

## **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:**

This item seeks Council approval to authorize the City Attorney to research, develop, and return with draft ordinances or policy options that address ongoing concerns regarding public space use, neighborhood livability, and the relationship between service providers and the surrounding community. The City Attorney would review relevant case law, identify best practices, and prepare language for Council consideration at a future meeting.

## PROCESS OF AGENDA ITEM:

- 1. If item remains on consent, no presentation of item is required. Item would be approved as a consent calendar item.
- 2. If item is removed from the consent calendar; item would be placed at the end of the regular agenda items for discussion following the process below:
  - a. Presentation of agenda item by the City Attorney
  - b. Questions and discussion from Councilmembers
  - c. Public comment period
  - d. Council deliberation and motion

#### BACKGROUND:

The City of Sebastopol has received increasing community concern regarding quality-of-life issues in neighborhoods and commercial areas, particularly related to unsheltered homelessness, property/site maintenance, and behavior in public spaces. In response, staff recommends developing potential ordinances or policies to address these concerns while balancing the City's legal responsibilities and service obligations.

## **DISCUSSION:**



Direction from the Council would authorize the City Attorney to review relevant case law, examine ordinances from comparable jurisdictions, and determine the legal parameters for adoption of good neighbor, property maintenance, and public space use regulations. Draft options would then be returned to Council for review, refinement, and possible adoption.

# STAFF (RESPONSIBLE DEPARTMENT) ANALYSIS:

The City Manager's Office and the City Attorney recommend that Council direct staff to conduct legal research, review best practices, and prepare draft language or policy frameworks for further discussion at a future Council meeting.
