Subject: Authorization for the Mayor to Sign onto the "Mayors for Equal Rights Amendment

(ERA)" Petition

Recommendation: That the City Council authorize the Mayor to sign onto the "Mayors for ERA" petition in

support of recognition of the Equal Rights Amendment (ERA).

RECOMMENDATION:

That the City Council approve and authorize the Mayor to sign onto the "Mayors for ERA" petition in support of recognition of the Equal Rights Amendment (ERA).

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The "Mayors for ERA" petition is a national effort to demonstrate widespread municipal support for recognition and enforcement of the ERA. Authorizing the Mayor to sign onto the petition would reaffirm Sebastopol's commitment to equity, inclusion, and human rights.

PROCESS OF AGENDA ITEM:

- 1. If item remains on consent, no presentation of item is required. Item would be approved as a consent calendar item
- 2. If item is removed from the consent calendar; item would be placed at the end of the regular agenda items or as otherwise determined the Mayor for discussion following the process below:
 - a. Presentation of agenda item by the Mayor
 - b. Questions and discussion from Councilmembers
 - c. Public comment period
 - d. Council deliberation and motion

BACKGROUND:

The Equal Rights Amendment (ERA) was passed by Congress in 1972 and sent to the states for ratification. The amendment states: "Equality of rights under the law shall not be denied or abridged by the United States or by any state on account of sex."

In January 2020, Virginia became the 38th state to ratify the ERA, fulfilling the constitutional requirement for adoption. Despite this, the ERA has not yet been fully recognized as part of the U.S. Constitution.

The "Mayors for ERA" petition is a national effort to mobilize mayors across the country to demonstrate local government support for the recognition and enforcement of the ERA. The petition affirms the principle that equality under the law should be guaranteed regardless of sex and calls on federal leaders to act.

DISCUSSION:

The City of Sebastopol was approached by California NOW (CA NOW), which has been working on a statewide effort to advance the Equal Rights Amendment. CA NOW is reaching out to Democratic House Members to co-sponsor House Joint Resolution 80, and is also mobilizing support from local governments.

On August 5, 2025, the City of Sebastopol proclaimed August 26, 2025, as Women's Equality Day in the City, marking the 105th anniversary of the enactment of the 19th Amendment, celebrating the achievements of women, and recommitting to gender equality in Sebastopol.

Signing the "Mayors for ERA" petition would further demonstrate Sebastopol's support for equity, inclusion, and human rights. The action carries no fiscal cost and is consistent with the City's values of fairness and social justice.

Municipalities across the United States have joined this effort, signaling broad local government support for the ERA.

I strongly support the Equal Rights Amendment to the United States Constitution as the 28th Amendment and which reads:

The ERA passed the Congress by the needed 2/3rd vote of the United States House and the Senate and by the legislatures of the needed 38 states.

Congress must immediately recognize the Equal Rights Amendment and pass the following United States House and Senate resolutions:

Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, that notwithstanding any time limit contained in House Joint Resolution 208, 92nd Congress, as agreed to in the Senate on March 22, 1972, the article of amendment proposed to the States in that joint resolution is valid to all intents and purposes as part of the Constitution, having been ratified by the legislatures of three-fourths of the several States.
