CITY OF SEBASTOPOL RESOLUTION NO. 6703-2025

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEBASTOPOL ACKNOWLEDGING THE ANCESTRAL LANDS OF THE SOUTHERN POMO AND COAST MIWOK PEOPLES

WHEREAS, the City of Sebastopol is located on the ancestral homelands of the Southern Pomo and Coast Miwok peoples, who have been the stewards and caretakers of these lands since time immemorial; and

WHEREAS, the Federated Indians of Graton Rancheria represent descendants of the Southern Pomo and Coast Miwok peoples and continue to uphold cultural, spiritual, and environmental stewardship of their ancestral territories; and

WHEREAS, acknowledging Indigenous lands is a meaningful step toward honoring the history, presence, and ongoing contributions of Native peoples; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sebastopol recognizes the importance of educating the public and promoting awareness of Indigenous history, culture, and rights; and

WHEREAS, other local governments, educational institutions, and organizations in Sonoma County have adopted land acknowledgments as a formal practice to demonstrate respect and recognition of Indigenous peoples; and

WHEREAS, this acknowledgment does not replace authentic relationships with Indigenous communities but serves as a gesture of respect and a commitment to awareness, education, and reconciliation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Sebastopol hereby:

- Acknowledges that the City of Sebastopol is situated on the unceded ancestral homelands of the Southern Pomo and Coast Miwok peoples;
- Commits to recognizing and honoring the past, present, and future generations of these Indigenous peoples, including the Federated Indians of Graton Rancheria;
- Directs that a land acknowledgment statement(shortened version) be incorporated into City
 Council meetings by being printed on Council agendas or read aloud by the Mayor at the Mayor's
 discretion; The City of Sebastopol acknowledges that we live and work within the unceded
 ancestral homelands of the Southern Pomo and the Coast Miwok people. We pay our respect to
 the past, present, and future generations of these peoples, including the Federated Indians of
 Graton Rancheria; and
- Encourages consideration of including this practice in the City's subsidiary bodies, such as standing committees, ad hoc committees, boards, commissions, and other future committees or bodies;
- Directs staff to post the long version of the land acknowledgment statement on the City's website under the "History of Sebastopol" section; The City of Sebastopol acknowledges that we live and work on the unceded ancestral homelands of the Southern Pomo and the Coast Miwok people, who have been the stewards and caretakers of these lands since time immemorial. We pay our respect to the past, present, and future generations of these peoples, including the Federated Indians of Graton Rancheria; and
- Affirms that this action aligns with the City Council's commitment to community vitality,
