June 3 City Council Meeting Agenda Summary

The [June 3 City Council Meeting Agenda](#) includes the following items:

- June Proclamations: June 19, 2025, as Juneteenth Day, June 2025 as Pride Month
- Informational Items:
 - Presentation from California Intergovernmental Risk Authority (CIRA) on overview of CIRA services and risk management efforts to protect member agency assets, including factors affecting City premiums.
 - Presentation outlining the executive search process used in selecting a City Manager.
 - Section 115 Pension Trust & Internal Reserve Update: Year-to-date update on pension-related accounts, highlighting investment performance and the City's fiscal responsibility.
 - Cost Allocation Plan Update for FY 2025–26: Summary of updated plan reallocating overhead costs to City funds like Water and Wastewater.
 - Presentation on the police response at Elderberry Commons.
- Public Hearings:
 - AB 2561 - City Vacancies: Required annual report on staff vacancies; City currently has 9 vacancies (under 6%).
 - Street Lighting Assessment FY 2025–26: Approve Engineer's Report and increase annual street lighting fee from \$32 to \$35 per household.
 - Capital Improvement Plan for Fiscal Year 2025-26: Note changes, if any, and adopt a Resolution.
 - Review and consider the Proposed Operating Budget for Fiscal Year 2025-26.
- Police Support Services Manager Title & Pay Update: Retitle and revise the position, with an 8% recommended pay increase reflecting expanded duties.
- Resolution Update – Unrepresented Employee Compensation: Amendments to compensation and benefits for unrepresented employees.
- Pay Rate Amendment – 3% COLA: 3% cost-of-living adjustment for three positions, effective July 1, 2025.

- Direction for Sonoma County Mayors Meeting – Association of Bay Area Governments (ABAG) Seats: Provide direction on appointments to two ABAG Executive Board seats for 2-year terms.
