Subject: Possible Mural Locations and Next Steps Discussion and Action

Background:

At the regular May 28, 2026, Public Arts Committee (PAC) meeting, the PAC created an ad hoc subcommittee of two (2) members – Gavin Waters and Nicole Letaw – to look into possible sculpture and mural locations throughout the City of Sebastopol that might be suitable for public art pieces such as the Pomo/Miwok public art piece.

The subcommittee has located potential mural locations. The purpose of this item is to open a discussion with the full PAC. The focus will be on the Pomo/Miwok mural piece and outline broader procedures for other mural artists moving forward.

Discussion:

1. How does the PAC want to move forward with the call for Pomo/Miwok piece?
2. Financial options?
 - a. Pomo/Miwok piece has a City Council approved \$3,000 budget
 - b. There are funds in the City art in lieu fund
3. How and who will reach out to private property owners with potential locations for other pieces?
